






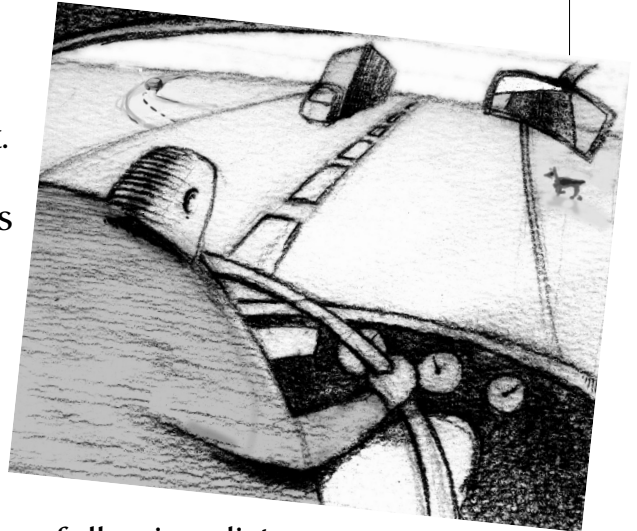


The Golden Rule of Safe Driving
